

# STYLE STROKES

Singapore illustrators Herman Yap, Ping Lee and Teng Lixian have made it into a British fashion illustration book.

They are among 250 international artists and illustrators showcased in *Big Book Of Fashion Illustration* by Martin Dawber.

The book is touted as a global directory of style with the works of artists categorised under sections such as menswear, womenswear, accessories and beauty.

It was published last month by British company Batsford, and home-grown book retailer and publishing house Page One concurrently released an Asian edition.

Yap, 32, whose works (right) have been featured in *Urban* and local publication *Nuyou*, says: "Although this
